## GRANTS GIVEN for PARK STATUARY

Two grants have been received by the Tillamook County Library Foundation for the purchase of statuary for the proposed library park. The park will be sited on land adjacent to the west side of the Tillamook County Library Main Branch. Earnings from the Library Foundation's endowment were used to purchase this land.

The Tillamook County Cultural Coalition (TCCC) awarded the Foundation a grant of \$1000. The Oregon Cultural Trust is the primary funder of the grant through a sub-grant to the TCCC.

The Tillamook Revitalization Association (TRA) also awarded the Foundation a grant of \$1000. The TRA is a local non-profit dedicated to the support of projects aimed at revitalizing the City of Tillamook.

*Both grants will be used towards the purchase of the statue "Dancing Children."*

# Let's Build a Park One Square Foot at a Time

Land adjacent to the west side of the Tillamook County Library Main Branch was purchased by the Tillamook County Library Foundation with the dream of creating an outdoor community and learning space for the people of Tillamook County. Plans are moving forward, but the Foundation needs your help to raise money to provide statuary and other amenities for the park.

To that end, the park area has been divided into square foot plots. The plots are numbered from 1 to 7,150. Park Plots go on sale starting March 15. Each plot sells for only \$5. The buyer will receive a "deed" for each plot purchased. All sales take place at the Tillamook County Main Library in Tillamook.

Deeds make an awesome remembrance of birthdays, weddings or anniversary dates and are suitable for framing.

Specific plot numbers maybe be requested. These numbers are sold on a first come, first serve basis.

The Library Park is a community project. The land was purchased by the Tillamook County Library Foundation using earnings from its endowment. The endowment is made up of gifts from Tillamook County citizens.
