Question 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.

Shall Tillamook School District issue \$4,000,000 in bonds plus receive up to \$4,000,000 in State matching grants for facility needs? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

Match - A State grant of \$1.93 million will be awarded; the District is on waiting list to receive additional match of \$2.1 million. Both amounts are available only if bond passes.

Cost - Property owners are projected to pay approximately \$0.70/\$1,000 on the 2002 bond next year. If passed, this bond would increase that rate by approximately \$0.08/\$1,000 (\$8 per year for every \$100,000 of assessed property value) to approximately \$0.78/\$1,000. Actual rates vary depending upon assessed value and interest rates. This bond will mature in eight years or less as will the 2002 bonds.

Results - Expected projects include:

- Safety projects (doors/locks; exterior lighting; fire alarm upgrades; remove hazardous material)
- Adding classroom space, building a cafeteria and improving facilities
- Building covered play areas at elementary schools
- Parking/traffic flow projects
- Site improvements, furnishing and equipping of projects and bond issuance costs
- Replacing and repairing deteriorating roofs; other maintenance projects
- Replacing heating/ventilation units

Process - A prioritized list of projects will be used to identify the order and scope of projects to complete.


