This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

Summary 175 words

This measure would continue the five year local option tax by Cannon Beach Fire Protection District paying for training, vehicle, administrative costs and salary for funding the position of the full-time District Fire Chief. The Fire Chief directs 25 volunteer firefighters who respond to approximately 330 calls annually for emergency medical problems, fires, highway accidents, surf & cliff rescues and hazardous material incidents. The Fire Chief manages compliance with state and federal regulations, disaster planning and mutual aid agreements with neighboring communities. The Fire Chief also manages budgets, maintenance of fire trucks, equipment, and stations valued at over \$4 million dollars. Estimated tax impact is \$0.1488 per thousand of assessed property value, or \$14.88 on a \$100,000 home in the first year. The local option tax collected between July 2014 and June 2019 is \$141,469 annually, or \$707,345 in total. The estimated cost of this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of estimate.

Resolution 13-4

A Resolution of the Cannon Beach Rural Fire Protection District to

Seek Voter Approval of a Local Option Tax

WHEREAS, Cannon Beach Rural Fire Protection District ("the District") desires to fund the position of full-time Fire Chief for the five-year period of 2014-2019; and

WHEREAS, additional property tax revenues are needed to fund the position of Fire Chief; and

WHEREAS, the District is authorized by ORS 478.410 to levy taxes on assessed value of all taxable property within the District; and

WHEREAS, section 11(4), Article XI of the Oregon Constitution permits a local taxing district to impose a local option tax, with voter approval;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Board of Directors of the District hereby calls for an election on the question of whether the District may levy a five-year local option tax on all taxable property within the District for the purposes of funding the position of Fire Chief;
- 2. That such election shall be held on Tuesday, May 21, 2013, within the boundaries of Cannon Beach Rural Fire Protection District in Clatsop and Tillamook counties, Oregon.
- 3. That the Ballot Title for such election, which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1, shall be the Ballot Title to be submitted to Clatsop and Tillamook County Elections Office for placement on the ballot.
