(Section 33(i)); subverting citizen input at public meetings; creating a hostile work environment for both managers and represented employees; and campaign violations during the 2010 election.</p> <p>JUSTIFICATION STATEMENT AS PROVIDED BY DENNIS PORTER:</p> <p>As mayor, I am governed by the City Charter passed in the year 2008. In this Charter, under Chapter III, Section 7: MAYOR. The Mayor shall preside over all meetings and deliberations of the City Council and <u>be privileged to all City business.</u> The Mayor shall nominate for appointment by a majority of the Council: Liaison Councilors; members of all committees; Heads of Departments; other persons as required by the Council; laws, rules or ordinances.</p> <p>This activity was seen by the City Manager as informing the Mayor only when he felt it was necessary. When naming department heads, the City Manager considered it his responsibility.</p> <p>When Council meets, it is the Mayor's responsibility to ensure civility by the council and the audience.</p> <p>As for creating a hostile work environment, this was caused by the City Manager conducting City business that should have been brought to the Mayor and City Council.</p> <p>If there were campaign violations during the 2010 election (and there were not), a complaint should have been filed with the Elections Board, and there was not.
