

**29-120 Referendum of Tillamook City Ordinance #1223 amending Ordinance #1014.**

Should City raise the business license tax on motor vehicle fuel dealers to pay for street construction, maintenance and lighting?

In 1982, Tillamook Citizens passed a business license tax on motor vehicle fuel dealers based upon 1.5 cents per gallon of fuel sold. These revenues are used solely for construction, reconstruction, improvement, repair, maintenance and lighting of city streets.

City's costs for materials, services and electricity have increased for 26 years without any increase in the business license tax on fuel dealers.

City is asking for an additional 1.5 cents per gallon of fuel sold on the business license tax on fuel dealers to help maintain and light City streets.

A Yes vote would raise the business license tax on motor vehicle fuel dealers from 1.5 cents to 3 cents per gallon of fuel sold.

A No vote would leave the business license tax on motor vehicle fuel dealers at 1.5 cents per gallon of fuel sold.

This ordinance was referred to voters by a referendum petition filed by Floyd Walker.
