

TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON.  
DEPENDENT RESURVEY, SUBDIVISION OF SECTION AND SURVEY OF TRACT 37.

This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 1 S., R. 8 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original location according to the best available evidence; the subdivision of section 7 and survey of Tract No. 37.

Excepting as new or modified vacant subdivisions as shown hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved January 8, 1884.

The west boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines were surveyed by Henry Meldrum, Deputy Surveyor, in 1883.

A portion of the west boundary and subdivisional lines were retraced, and the survey of the township was completed by Frank H. Sharp, Deputy Surveyor, in 1893.

A portion of west boundary and subdivisional lines were resurveyed by Lynn M. Roseberry, Cadastral Surveyor, in 1963.

Survey executed by Floyd A. Brooks and Lester E. Fischer, Cadastral Surveyors from May 10, 1974 to October 14, 1975, under Special Instructions dated February 13, 1974, which provide for the surveys included under Group No. 832, Oregon.

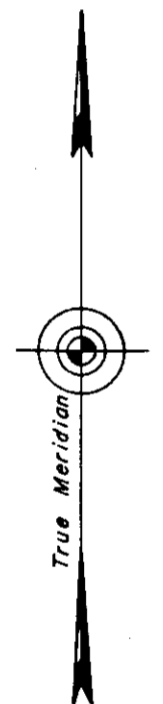
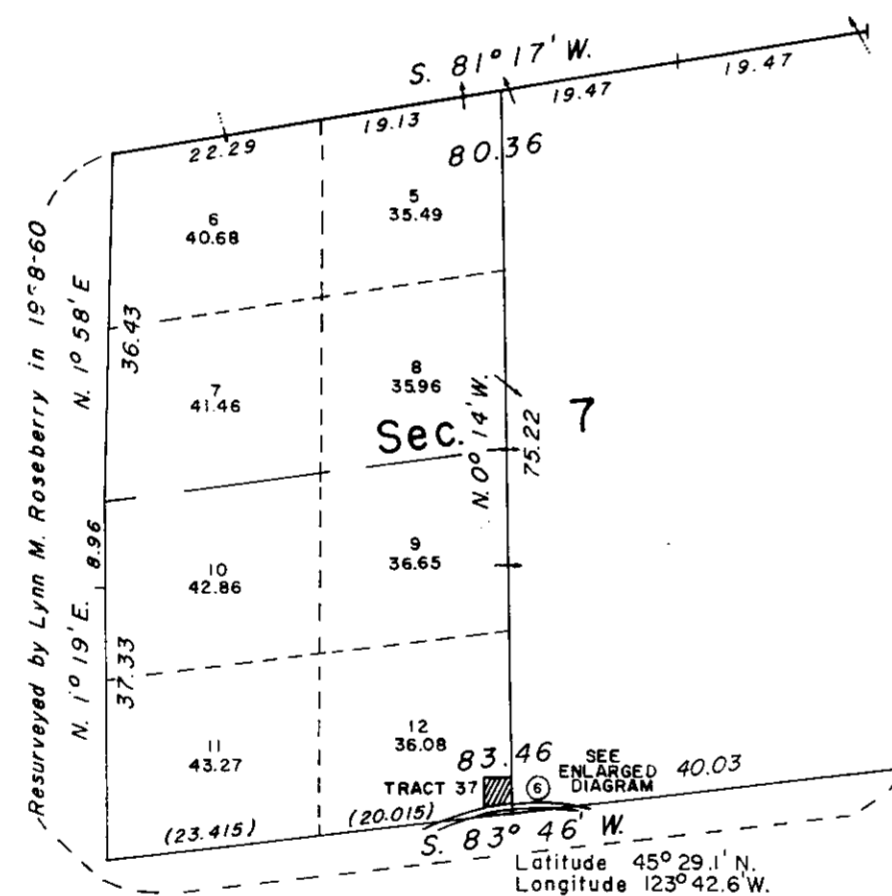

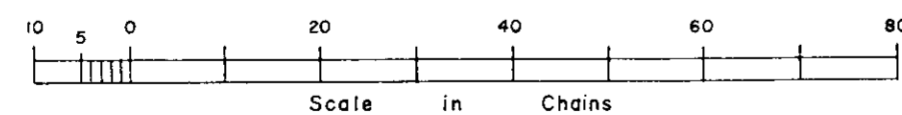

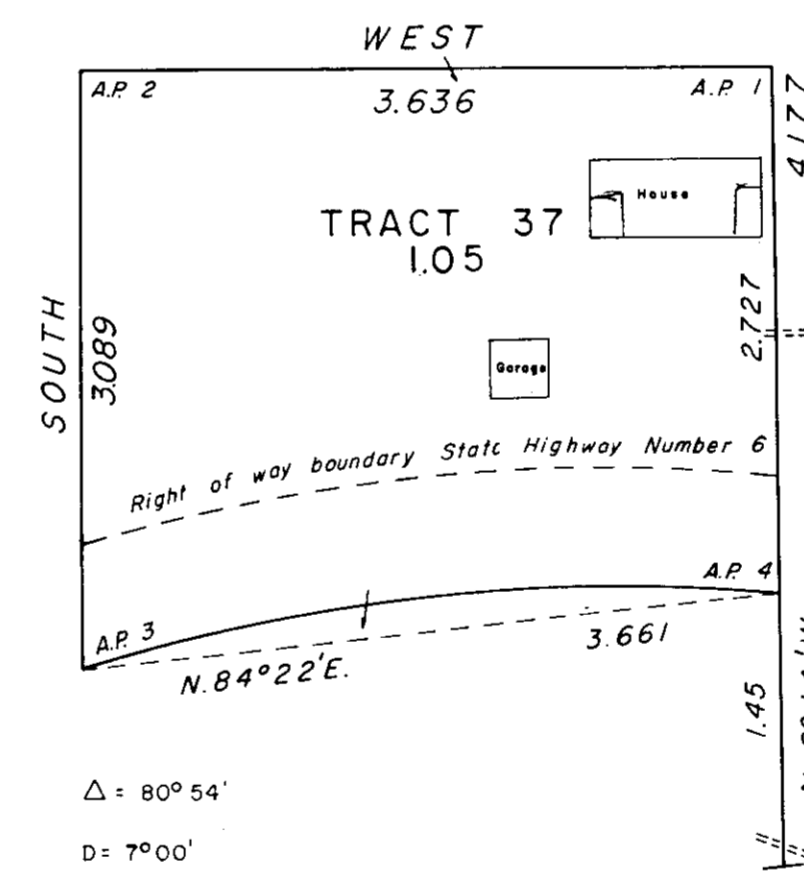


MEAN

21°30'E.

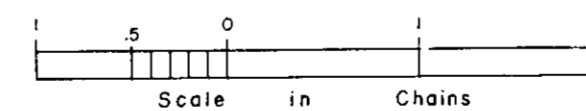
