

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7, and 8 Township 1 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL Post, now missing, from which a:

- 8" Hemlock bears N 79 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 51 lks.; now 7" down, BT and traces of other scribes visible.
- 7" Hemlock bears S39E 44 lks.; now 8" down, roots in place, T1 part of B and T scribes visible.
- 40" Hemlock bears S50W 38 lks.; now 61" stub 250 ft. high, T1 BT scribes visible.
- 6" Hemlock bears N6W 24 lks.; now just roots remaining.

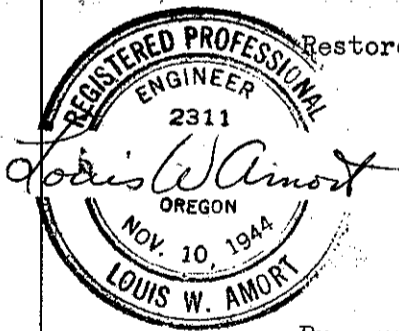
Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T1S R7W S5 S6 S7 S8 1954 RE 2311," 30 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 67" Fir stump bears N30 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 108.7 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S6 BT RE 2311.
- 78" Fir snag bears N47E 200 $^{\circ}$; scribed T1S R7W S5 BT
- 30" x 30" x 40" rounded sandstone boulder bears S48E 31.8 Ft.; scribed B0. (Corner point is on west edge of .2 acre flat.)

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 3" Fir N89E 29.8 ft. Set 4" x 4" x 72" White Cedar post 1.5 ft. NE of pipe. Also poster on 48" fir stump 594.0 ft. South of corner on ridge top.
