## RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

## ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

Hemlock bears S70°E 5 lks.; now 42" stub 40 ft. high, portion of 1/4 scribes visible. 28" Hemlock bears N57°W 26 lks.; now 28" stub 30 ft. high, face burnt out.

## RESTORED

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S15 S14 1954 RE 2311," 33 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

3" Fir bears S772°W 117.8 ft.; scribed X 48" Fir snag bears S12°E 42.9 ft.; scribed 1/4 S14 BT RE 2311

Also poster on 48" Fir snag BT.

4" x 4" x 72" white Cedar post 1 ft. NW of pipe.
