36" Hemlock bears N20½ W 29 lks.; now 26", down, roots in place, face and scribes burnt off.

- 52" Fir stump bears N36°W 99.0 ft.; scribed T3N R6W S19 BT.
- 36" Fir stub 25' high bears S8°W 53.9 ft.; scribed T3N R6W S30 BT.
