

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 18 and 19,
Township 2 North, Range 7 West, W.M.,
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone, now missing, (see 1952 restoration)
from which a:

- 8" Hemlock bears N6°W 21 lks.; now missing.
- 18" Hemlock bears S55°E 59 lks.; now missing.

RESTORATION by L. W. Amort, December 17, 1952.

1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe 10 ft. West of
corner point as a witness corner (point now
destroyed by roadwork) from which a:

- 56" Fir snag bears N58½°W 83.3 ft.; I destroyed
markings.
- 68" Fir stump bears S30°E 137.0 ft.; I destroyed
markings (markings on above BT's destroyed
after true corner point was located)

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 24" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S18 S19
1954 RE 2311,"

20 inches in roadbed on South side. Erected
mound of stone around pipe from which a:

- 52" Fir stump bears S45¼°E 144.4 ft.;
scribed ¼ S19 BT RE 2311.
- 33" Fir snag bears N86½°E 23.0 ft.;
scribed ¼ S18 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 33"
Fir snag BT.

Also poster on 52" Fir stump BT.

4" x 5" x 80" white Cedar post 1 ft. East of pipe.
