

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 8,
Township 2 North, Range 8 West, W.M., Tillamook
County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone 16" x 10" x 7" out of place, marks now
weathered and uncertain from which a:

- 40" Fir bears N50°W 19 lks.; now missing,
roots in place.
- 24" Hemlock bears S20°W 18 lks.; now 20"
stub 30 ft. high, BT scribes visible.

RESTORED

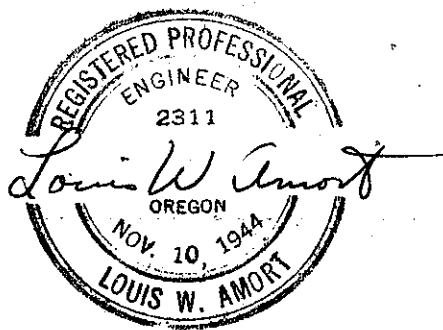
Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4,"
35 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 60" Fir stump bears S65°E 28.2 ft.;
scribed 1/4 S8 BT RE 2311.
- 40" Fir stump bears N1°W 32.6 ft.;
scribed 1/4 S5 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on
60" Fir stump BT.
4" x 4" x 72" white Cedar post 1.5 ft. SW of pipe.
also posted on original 24" Hemlock BT.
