Post, now missing, 18^n chunk of $1\frac{1}{2}^n$ rusted pipe in place, from which a:

60" Cedar bears S15 W 38 lks.; now 66" stump, badly burned and rotted, 2 original faces and axe marks remaining.

24" Hemlock bears East 2 lks.; now rotted and broken up, slid east about 2 ft. into new creek channel.

40.20 Brook, 1 lk. N70°E; old channel now in place, new channel 10 ft. south.

81 Fir bears S8 W 49.8 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S27 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 8th Fir BT SSW.

 $4^{11} \times 5^{11} \times 7^{11}$ white Cedar post 2 ft. east of pipe.
