

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 10, 11, 14 and 15  
Township 1 South, Range 8 West, W.M.,  
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

18" x 10" x 10" stone, now missing, from which a:

- 18" Hemlock bears N52°W 4 lks.; now missing.
- 24" Hemlock bears N42°E 3 lks.; now missing.
- 20" Hemlock bears S20°E 19 lks.; now missing, slide area.
- 8" Hemlock bears S66°W 64 lks.; now missing.

RESTORATION by W. E. Anderson, December 21, 1931.

4" x 4" x 30" Fir limb, SC scribed on one side, now down and out of place, from which a:

- 8" Hemlock bears N83°W 59.0 ft.; now missing.
- 16" Hemlock bears N38°W 60.7 ft.; now missing.
- 24" Hemlock bears N70°E 34.8 ft.; now 31" stub 30 ft. high, BT SC scribes visible.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked, "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T1S R3W S10 S11 S15 S14 1954 RE 2311," 32 inches in ground, in small mound of stone, and from which a:

- 6" Alder bears N83°W 50.0 ft.; scribed T1S R3W S10 BT.
- 7" Alder bears S65½°W 44.3 ft.; scribed T1S R3W S15 BT RE 2311.
- 6" Alder bears S41½°E 48.0 ft.; scribed T1S R3W S14 BT.
- 7" Spruce bears N73°E 85.3 ft.; scribed T1S R3W S11 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 6" Alder BT S41½°E.

Also poster on 24" Hemlock N70°E.

Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white Cedar post on East edge Trask. cut off road approx. 660' West of corner.

4" x 4" x 60" white Cedar post 1.5' SE of pipe.
