Basalt stone  $18" \times 10" \times 8" \frac{1}{4}$  on W face now in place from which a:

26" Hemlock bears N71°E 11 1ks.; now 25" 50 ft. high

stub, BT scribes remaining.
30" Hemlock bears S79°W 41 lks.; now 32" 50 ft. high stub, portion of T scribe remaining.

## RESTORED

Erected mound of rock around corner stone, from which a:

36" Fir snag bears N27°E 97.2 ft.; scribed & S25 BT. 49" Fir snag bears  $N85_2^{10}$ W 18.5 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S26 BT RE 2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 49" Fir snag BT. Set 3"x3"x72" white Cedar post 1 ft. SE of pipe.
