Section corner common to Sections 16, 15, 21 and 22 T2N, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

- 16"x9"x5" stone, now in place with 3 notches on E and 3 on S sides, from which a:
 - 24" Hemlock bears N24°E 9 lks.; now 38" snag BT scribes remaining.
 - 18" Hemlock bears S59°E 53 lks.; now 30" stub 15 ft. high, edge of burnt face remaining.
 - 16" Hemlock bears S56°W 53 lks.; now 24" stub 8 ft. high, edge of burnt face remaining.
 - 8" Hemlock bears N8°W 70 lks.; now 10" stub 3 ft. high badly burnt.
