

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Township corner common to Sections 1 and 36, T. 3 & 4N.,
R. 7W, W.M., Tillamook and Clatsop Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, found rotted stake point in place
from which a:

- 36" Hemlock bears S38°W 18 lks.; now 31" stump,
face and scribes burnt out.
- 24" Hemlock bears N47°W 34 lks.; now 36" stump,
scribes S36 visible, rest unexposed.

RESTORED

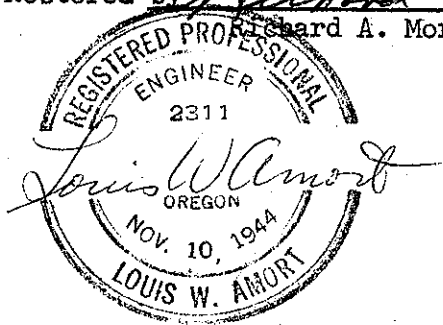
Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T4N T3N R7W
R6W S36 S6 S1 T3N 1955 RE 2311," 32 inches in ground,
in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 55" Fir stump bears S9½°W 118.8 ft.; scribed
T3N R7W S1 BT.
- 36" Fir stump bears N83°W 59.1 ft.; scribed
T4N R7W S36 BT RE 2311.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white Cedar post 2' E of pipe.
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on
36" Fir stump BT.
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on
4" x 4" x 50" white Cedar post on N edge Rd. approx.
260' S.
