

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Closing township corner common to Sections 6 and 31,
T 3 & 4 N, R 6 W, W.M., Tillamook & Clatsop Counties,
Oregon.

ORIGINAL

6" Hemlock now missing, from which a:

- 14" Hemlock bears $N44\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ 32 lks.; now 22" snag,
trace of scribe visible on edge of burnt out face.
- 5" Hemlock bears $S17^{\circ}E$ 59 lks.; now missing, point
falls in old skid road.
- 8" Hemlock bears $N62\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 65 lks.; now 13" uproot,
roots and root hole in place, scribes BT visible,
upper face burnt out.

RESTORED

Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T4N R6W S36
S31 S6 CC T3N 1955 RE 2311," 32 inches in ground,
in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 5" Fir bears $S67^{\circ}E$ 66.0 ft.; scribed T3N R6W S6 CC BT.
- 41" Cedar stump bears $N20^{\circ}E$ 13.5 ft.; scribed T4N
R6W S31 CC BT RE 2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on
41" Cedar stump BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white Cedar post 1.5' NW of pipe.
