One quarter corner common to Section 12 (East side) T3N, R7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon

ORTGINAL.

Stone $14^{11} \times 10^{11} \times 6^{11}$, now broken up and in place with $\frac{1}{4}$ on W face from which a:

30" Fir bears West 11 1ks.; now 31" stump, badly burnt.
5" V. Maple bears S53°E 36 1ks.; now missing, Vine Maple clumps in vicinity.

RESTORED

Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY $\frac{1}{4}$ S12 1955 RE2311," 34 inches in ground with pieces of $\frac{3}{4}$ stone on N edge pipe in mound of stone, and from which a:

55" Fir stump bears N31°W 57.8 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S12 BT RE2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 32" Fir snag N68°W 27.6 ft.
Set 4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar post 1 ft. NE of pipe.
