One quarter corner common to Section 7 (West side) T. 1 S., R. 8 W., W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

18" Hemlock bears S59°W 13 lks.; now 42" chopped out S scribe, remainder unexposed.
10" Hemlock bears N62°E 38 lks.; now 10" 5 ft. high rotted stub.

## RESTORED

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY  $\frac{1}{4}$  S7 1955 RE 2311," 30 inches in ground, and from which a:

24" Spruce bears N54°W 44.7 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S7 BT. 23" Spruce bears S89°E 17.0 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S7 BT RE 2311

Set 4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar post 1 ft. SW of pipe. Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on Original 18" Hemlock BT.

Also poster on 23" Spruce BT.

Also poster on 12" Hemlock on ridge top 230.0 ft. South.
