RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 17 and 20, T3N, R6W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

## DRIGINAL

Water worn stone 16"x12"x8", in place, from which a:

30" Hemlock bears N70°45'E 51 lks.; now 16" 4 ft. high stub, original axe work on edges burnt out face.

60" Fir bears S21°E 10 lks.; now 54" stump, scribe \(\frac{1}{4}\) visible, lower face unexposed.

60" Fir bears N21°W 42 lks.; now 48" stump, scribes 4 S BT visible.

## RESTORED

Erected mound of rock around  $\frac{1}{4}$  stone from which a:

6" Fir bears N17°E 43.5 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S17 BT RE2311. 5" Fir bears S50°E 4.9 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S20 BT.

Set 4"x3"x72" white painted Cedar post 2 ft. SW of corner.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 5" Fir BT.

Also poster on 4"x3"x72" white painted Cedar post on W edge road 64.1 ft. West of corner.
