40" Hemlock bears \$62°W 17.5 lks.; just roots and root hole remaining.

RES TORED

Set 12" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T3N \$24 \$19 \$30 CC R6W 1955 RE2311," 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

> 26" Fir stump bears \$37°E 112.1 ft.; scribed T3N R6W S30 CC BT RE2311.

Set 4" x 4" x 72" white painted Cedar post 2 ft. W of pipe. Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on original 54" BT.
