16" Hemlock bears North 16 lks.; now 20" stub 4' high, scribes BT visible, upper face burnt out.
75" Spruce bears S14°E 46 lks.; now 80" snag, scribes BT visible, upper face unexposed.

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S8 S17 1957 RS401," 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

7" Fir bears S69½°W 7.4 ft.; scribed 1/4 S17 BT RS401. 6" Fir bears N27°W 43.8 ft.; scribed 1/4 S8 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on  $7^n$  Fir BT. Set  $4^n \times 4^n \times 60^n$  white painted Cedar post 1.0' NW of pipe.
