24" Hemlock bears N78°E 53 lks.; now 28" snag, scribes 1/4 s visible, lower face unexposed. 30" Hemlock bears N28°W 10 lks.; now 36" uproot, roots and root hole in place, scribes 1/4 s BT visible.

RESTORED

Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S17 S16 1957 RS401," 33 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

60" Fir stump bears N $28\frac{1}{2}$ °E 32.3 ft.; scribed 1/4 S16 BT RS401 49" Fir stump bears S450W 119.4 ft.; scribed 1/4 S17 BT.

20" x 20" x 20' rock mound bears S780W 110.0 ft.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 60" Fir stump BT. Set 4" x 4" x 60" white Cedar post 2.0' SW of pipe.
