CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One Quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 6,
T. 2S, R. 7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (now missing) from which a:

- 5" Fir bears N6E 22 lks.; now 12" stump, scribe S visible, lower face unexposed, and scribe 1/4 visible on down portion.
- 5" V. Maple bears S52 1/2 W 18 lks.; now missing.

RESTORED

Var. 21 1/2 E

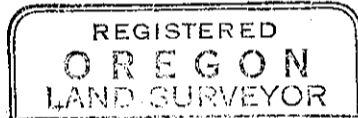
Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S6 S5 1958 RS401", 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

53" Fir stump bears S10W 170.3 ft.; scribed 1/4 S6 BT RS401.

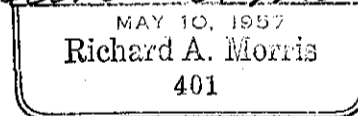
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 53" Fir stump B.T.
