RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 3, 4, 9, 10,  
T1N, R10W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon

ORIGINAL

Post (missing) from which a:

- 6" Hemlock bears N25E 14 lks.; now 9", scribe S visible, rest rotted off.
- 15" Hemlock bears N78W 36 lks.; now 24" stub 3' high, badly rotted.
- 3" Hemlock bears S44W 33 lks.; (now 14.1 feet distance) scribe S visible, rest rotted away.
- 24" Hemlock bears S40E 14 lks.; now 37", scribe O visible, rest unexposed.

Var. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ E

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T1N R10W S4 S3 S9 S10 1959 RS401", 34 inches in ground, and from which a:

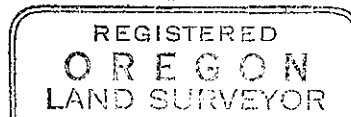
- 31" Hemlock bears N69W 20.7 ft.; scribed T1N R10W S4 BT RS401.
- 41" Hemlock bears N45 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 43.8 ft.; scribed T1N R10W S3 BT.
- 41" Hemlock bears S10W 34.4 ft.; scribed T1N R10W S9 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on original 24" Hemlock BT.

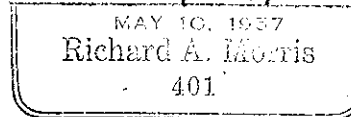
Set 4" x 4" x 52" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. N.E. of pipe.
