18" Stump with scribes BM 880.6 bears west 27.6
Center Line of logging road bears North 15.0 ft. Course N60°W.
Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 3" Cherry
N45½°E 23.7

Set 4 x 4 x 72" white painted Cedar post bears 1.0 ft. NW of corner pipe.
