Post (now missing) from which a:

10" Hemlock bears N41°W 14 lks.; now 24" stub 4' high, face and scribes rotted off.

8" Hemlock bears N64°E 23 lks.; now 16" stub 4' high, scribe S visible on partially exposed face.

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S15 S16 1957 RS401," 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

11" Fir bears N562°W 64.8 ft.; scribed 1/4 S16 BT RS401.
7" Spruce bears S43°E 51.3 ft.; scribed 1/4 S15 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 4° Spruce S50°W 2.3 ft. Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0' SE of pipe.
