

CHAINS

ESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

(see official plat)

Center South one-sixteenth corner common to Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1½" x 40" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY C—C S 1/16 S3 1953 2311," 34 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 45" Maple bears S59E 21.4 ft.; scribed CS 1/16 S3 BT.
- 26" Fir bears S56W 80.4 ft.; scribed CS 1/16 S3 BT RE 2311.

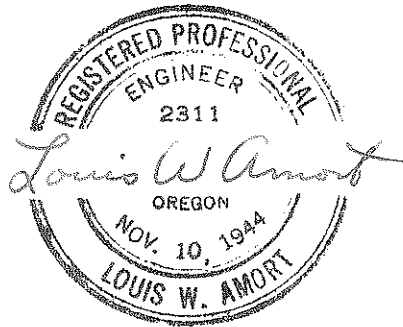
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 26" Fir BT.
