

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 35, 36, 1 and 2, Townships 2 and 3 South, Range 8 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 8" Hemlock bears N28W 43 lks.; now missing.
- 12" Hemlock bears N12E 34 lks.; now 24" snag, BT scribes visible.
- 10" Hemlock bears S56E 45 lks.; now 6" stub 2 ft. high, rotted and burned.
- 18" Cedar bears S29W 28 lks.; roots in place.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2S R8W S35 S36 S1 S2 T3S R8W 1953 2311," 32 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 32" Fir snag bears N50°30'W 12.5 ft.; scribed T2S R8W S35 BT RE 2311.
- 48" Cedar stump bears S53W 51.2 ft.; scribed T3S R8W S2 BT.
- 53" Cedar stump bears S61E 67.4 ft.; scribed T3S R8W S1 BT.
- 43" Fir snag bears N62E 56.9 ft.; scribed T2S R8W S36 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on south edge road 660 ft. south. White cedar post 1 foot north of pipe.
