

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, Township 1 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 14" Hemlock bears S19½E 80 lks.; now 15" stub 6 ft. high, scribe 10 visible.
- 12" Hemlock bears S42½W 75 lks.; now missing.
- 20" Hemlock bears N42½E 55 lks.; now missing.
- 12" Hemlock bears N11W 14 lks.; now 10" rotted root stub.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T1S R7W S3 S4 S9 S10 1953 2311," 30 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 36" Cedar snag bears N24W 43.8 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S4 BT.
- 77" Fir stump bears N26E 8.0 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S3 BT.
- 38" Fir snag bears S16W 93.4 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S9 BT RE 2311.
- 72" Fir stump bears S50E 72.3 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S10 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 4" x 4" x 60" white cedar post 2 ft. south of pipe.
