from which a:

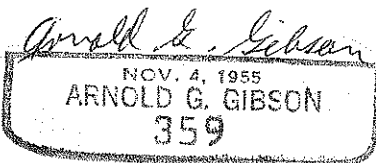
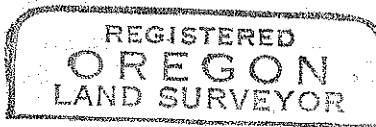
39" Fir snag bears  $N37^{\circ}E$ . 59.0 ft.; scribed W 1/16
