CHAINS

**Retracement, Township Line, bet. Tps. 4 and 5 S., R. 10 W.**

- Ascend 145 ft. over E. slope, across old logged area, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
- 5.10 Gravelled road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 35° W. and S. 35° E.
- 6.30 Spur, slopes N.; descend 207 ft. over NW. slope.
- 10.00 Point for the E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at record distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.
- 13.60 Trail, bears N. curving to NE. and S.
- 15.36 Plastic water pipe line, 2 ins. diam., bears N. and S.
- 18.70 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. 30° W.; ascend 40 ft. over NE. slope.
- 20.00 Point for the W-E 1/64 sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at record distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.
- 22.40 Top of ascent, slopes N.; descend 80 ft. over NW. slope.
- 22.50 High water line on SE. shore of Nestucca Bay, bears NE. and SW.; thence by triangulation across bay.
- 26.49 Point for the meander cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at record distance, falls below the high water line of Nestucca Bay; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.
- 67.70 Point for the meander cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at record distance, falls below the high water line of Nestucca Bay; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.
- 70.00 The true point for the cor. of Tps. 4 and 5 S., Rs. 10 and 11 W.

**Dependent Resurvey of the Township Line, bet. Tps. 4 and 5 S., R. 11 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon**

**(Restoring the 1924 survey by Lincoln E. Wilkes)**

- From the true point for the cor. of Tps. 4 and 5 S., Rs. 10 and 11 W.
- West, on record bearing, along the N. bdy. of Sec. 1, marking the true line.
- Across tide flat.
- 1.20 True point for the meander cor. of sec. 1 only, falls on unstable sand at high water line on the NW. shore of Nestucca Bay, where it is impracticable to establish a permanent monument.
- Ascend over sandy bank.
- 2.20 Point for the witness cor. to the meander cor. of sec. 1 only, falls on low sand ridge on E. side of North Spit.
