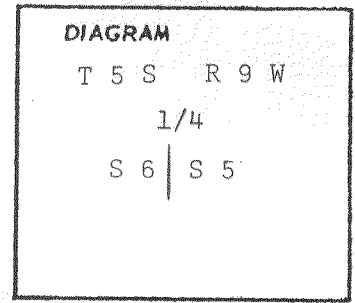


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally set by the G.L.O. in 1880 under Contract No. 364. They set a stone 10"x6"x4" for the corner and built a stone mound.



Description of corner evidence found:

I could find no evidence of the original corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At proportionate distance, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a brasscap riveted to the top marked:

T 5 S    R 9 W  
 1/4  
 S 6 | S 5  
 1975  
 RPLS 942

From which:

18" Fir S 26° W 25.5 feet  
 mkd. "1/4 S 6 BT"  
 11" Alder N 72° E 25.3 feet  
 mkd. "1/4 S 5 BT"

All bearing trees have been banded with red paint and attention signs and BT tags have been attached. All scribes have a 3/4" brass washer, with "LS 942 engraved on it, nailed in the face.
