CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON — DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Center-east one sixteenth corner for Section 12, T3N, R10W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ESTABLISHMENT by

Oregon State Board of Forestry, set pipe and cap, 1963 (missing) from which a:

32" Spruce bears N31°W 39.0 ft.; now 39" windfall.

17" Hemlock bears S37°W 54.8 ft.; now 18" stump in place, badly decayed, scribes CE 1/16 S12 BT visible.

WPCP bears SW 1.0 ft.; in place.

Center line Scovel Road bears East 39.7 ft.; in place.

RESTORED

Var. 211°E

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY E 1/16 C-C S12 1979 RS707", 34 inches in ground, and from which a:

12" Cedar bears S31½°E 60.4 ft. to face; scribed CE 1/16 S12 BT RS707.

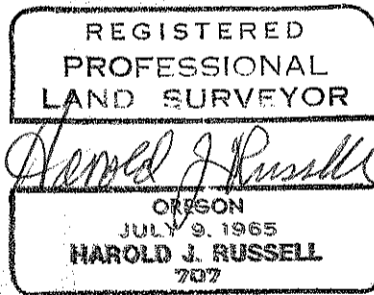
6" Alder bears N33°W 24.4 ft. to face; barkscribed CE 1/16 S12 BT.

4" x 4" x 72" white painted Cedar post SW 1.0 ft. from corner pipe.

Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on telephone pole N72°E 58.9 ft.
