40" Fir bears S58°W 24 lks.; now a 40" stump S66°W 19.0'.

REWITNESSED above stone by Lyle E. Beyers, RS 199 in 1949 from
which a:

34" Fir snag bears S66°W 32 lks.; now with scribes T1N S
visible on fallen snag.

46" Fir snag bears N13°E 45 lks.; now with scribe 9 visible.

40" Fir snag bears N42°W 38 lks.; now with scribes S7 199
visible on fallen snag.

56" Fir snag bears S53 1/2°E 29 lks.; now with scribes 199
visible.

12" Fir bears S36°W 23.0 ft. to face; scribed T1N R5W S18 BT.

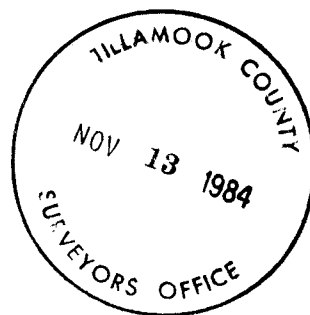
14" Fir bears S50°E 21.9 ft. to face; scribed T1N R5W S17 BT.
