3" Maple bears N26W 2 lks.; missing.

1 1/2"x40" Galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 36" in ground;
now 39" in ground, in place.

78" Fir stump bears N05 1/2E 17.4 ft.; now badly rotted with
scribes 1/4 S33 BT RE2311 visible, distance 17.6 ft.
16" Cedar snag S44 1/2E 78.6 ft.; now a 16" x 5 ft. high stump
with scribes 1/4 S4 BT visible.
