14" Hemlock bears N54E 49 lks.; missing.
8" Hemlock bears S59E 31 lks.; missing.
2 lk. Creek, course NE bears N89 53W 1 chain; in place course
S04W.

RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE2311, December 31, 1951 (Book 2,
page 102, Tillamook Co. Records.)

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in ground, in
mound of stone, on North edge of Fir log; now 40" in ground, in
place.

40" Fir stub, 8 ft. high bears S04E 29.5 ft.; now badly rotted
with scribes 1/4 S14 BT 2311 visible.
24" Hemlock snag bears N08E 89.5 ft.; now a 17" badly rotted,
uprooted stub with no scribes visible.

From above pipe with marks "LS1998 1990" added, a:

21" Fir bears N15E 42.5 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S11BT.
16" Fir bears S74W 14.8 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S14BT.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
