I found a 1 1/2" X 18" iron bar, approximately 3" deep in the left turn lane of U.S. Highway 101, (see Tillamook County Surveyors Rewitness Book 5 Page 201). I set a 5/8" X 12" iron rod with a 3" Tillamook County Surveyors Brass Cap in an 8" cast iron monument case and encased in concrete at the position of the found monument.

History of found monument

I found this monument to be as recorded in T.C.S. Rewitness Book 5 at page 201 and the references found and/or set at that time to now be as follows:

OSH R/W post & pin N.57 W. 52.93', shown on T.C.S. map #F-27-8 as 53.29', Reported in 1980 as N.60 W. 53.55' in same book and page; (Found, at the 1980 position. The pin is located 0.8' SE of the hat section post. The R/W post is rotted off).

OSH 1/4 cor post & pin S.76 30'W. 103.03', shown on T.C.S. map #F-27-8 as 102.98'; (Found bent, I straightened and reset in same hole, now 102.98'. The post is gone).

OSH R/W post & pin N.76 30'E. 76.18', shown on T.C.S. map #F27-8 as 76.92', reported in 1980 as 77.22' in same book and page; (Now gone).

New Accessory

*72" hat section post N.60 W. 54.1'.

Tack in the top of a 4"X 4" corner fence post N.76 E. 77.9'.

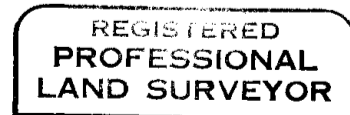
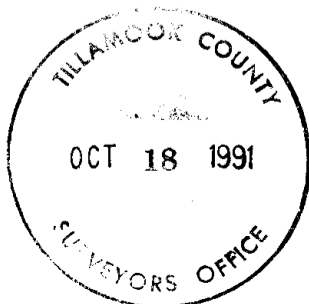
Location of Monument
