I found a 1" O.D. iron pipe with a rotten 2" X 2" wooden stake alongside, (see T.C.S. Map #A-3232), ± 24" below the surface. I set a 1 1/2" X 30" iron pipe with a 3" Tillamook County Surveyors Brass cap in a 10" concrete cylinder over the found iron pipe.

History of found monument

This Corner was rewitnessed for its historical value only and is not the true NE 1/16 of said section 36.

I found this monument to be as described above and its accessory evidence to now be as follows:

*(Map A-257) 24" live fir N.58°W. 48.8'; (Found, Now 40" fir, Face healed over, 46.5' to healed face).

*(Rewitness Book 4 Page 94) 5" alder S.18°W. 22.4'; (Found, Now 10" alder stretched scribing visible at bearing and distance).

New Accessory

*72" light hat section post N.30°E. 1.6'.
