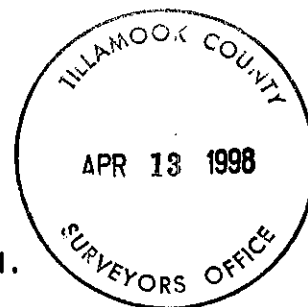
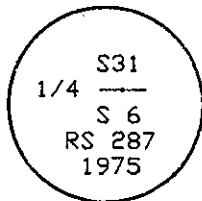

1/4 CORNER COMMON TO SECTION 31, T.3N., R.9W., W.M.
AND SECTION 6, T.2N., R.9W., W.M.



I FOUND A 2' IRON PIPE WITH A 3' TILLAMOOK COUNTY SURVEYORS BRASS CAP, SEE TILLAMOOK COUNTY SURVEYORS REWITNESS BIN #105, IN PILE OF VERY ROTTEN WOOD, I REFERENCED, REMOVED THE MONUMENT, AND DUG DOWN TO SOLID GROUND. THEN I RESET THE MONUMENT FROM REFERENCES AND ENCASED THE FOUND MONUMENT IN CONCRETE.

HISTORY OF FOUND MONUMENT

I FOUND THIS MONUMENT TO BE AS DESCRIBED IN TILLAMOOK COUNTY SURVEYORS REWITNESS #105 AND THE REFERENCES FOUND OR SET AT THAT TIME TO NOW BE AS FOLLOWS:

(G.L.D.) 10' SPRUCE SOUTH 1 LINK; (FOUND, NOW ROTTEN REMAINS, PART OF WHICH I DUG OUT TO RESET MONUMENT IN SOLID GROUND).

*(BOOK 4 PAGE 83) 70' CEDAR STUMP N.81 1/2°W. 66.3'; REPORTED AS FOUND, SCRIBING VISIBLE ON REWITNESS #105; (FOUND, FACE ROTTED OUT, AT BEARING AND DISTANCE).

*(BOOK 4 PAGE 83) 80' CEDAR STUMP S.47°W. 103.3'; REPORTED AS FOUND, SCRIBING VISIBLE ON REWITNESS #105; (FOUND, SCRIBING VISIBLE, AT BEARING AND DISTANCE).

*(BOOK 1 PAGE 316) 4' ALDER N.61°W. 3.8'; REPORTED AS FOUND 10' ALDER, SCRIBING VISIBLE, ON REWITNESS #105; (FOUND, NOW DOWN AND ROTTEN, NO MARKS VISIBLE).

(BOOK 1 PAGE 316) 7' ALDER S.9 1/2°W. 22.6'; REPORTED AS FOUND ON REWITNESS #105; (FOUND, NOW 18" STUMP, 18" HIGH, NO MARKS).

(REWITNESS #105) FOUND, WHITE CEDAR POST NE 1.5'; (FOUND, NOW ROTTEN AND LEANING AGAINST STUMP APPROXIMATELY 4' WEST OF CORNER).

(REWITNESS #105) 84' HAT SECTION POST SOUTH 1.5'; (FOUND, RESET AT 1.5' NORTH OF CORNER).

NEW ACCESSORIES

I FOUND THE 1' IRON PIPE, REPORTED ON REWITNESS CARD #105, AND SET IT FOR A REFERENCE, N.42°W. 3.19' TO NAIL IN WOODEN PLUG.

SET 5/8" IRON ROD WITH RED PLASTIC CAP, INSCRIBED 'TC SURVEY', WEST 243.13', FLUSH IN GRAVEL LOGGING ROD.

SET 5/8" IRON ROD WITH RED PLASTIC CAP, INSCRIBED 'TC SURVEY', NORTH 86.06', FLUSH IN GRAVEL LOGGING ROD.
