


Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 2 1/2" brass cap up 0.4'. The monument is stamped as shown hereon. Tied the monument directly using GPS established control. The Oregon North Zone State Plane in NAD 83/91 coordinate for the monument is N = 625922.780, E = 7321781.978 US Survey Feet. Found 1" Iron Pipe lying beside monument. Found a 6' tall, 4" X 4" white post marked, "S4 - S9" on corresponding sides, bears S 22° E 1.5' from monument. Found a carsonite "Survey Marker" paddleboard bears North 2.0' from monument. (G.L.O.) - Did not find the (12" dia. Hemlock bearing N 87° E 12 lks.). (G.L.O.) - Did not find the (12" dia. Hemlock bearing N 25° W 26 lks.). (G.L.O.) - Did not find the (18" dia. Hemlock bearing S 67 1/2° E 22 lks.). (G.L.O.) - Found 24" dia. (was 12"), Fir Stump, 7' tall, bears S 72° W 7.3' (S 82° W 11 lks.), scribing partially visible. (Book 3, Page 171) - Did not find the (22" dia. Fir bearing N 19° E 13 lks.). (Book 3, Page 171) - Found (50" dia.) Cedar Stump, 4' tall, bears (S 9°30' E 21 lks.), scribing partially visible, U.S.F.S. tag. (Book 3, Page 171) - Did not find the (19" dia. Hemlock bearing N 29° W 26 lks.). (Map B-1226 A&B) - Found 12" dia. (was 8"), Alder Stump, 7' tall, bears (N 55° E 3.2'), scribing visible, tag. (Map B-1226 A&B) - Found 14" dia. (was 5"), Hemlock Stump, 10' tall, bears (N 86° W 8.7'), healed scar and tag. (Map B-1226 A&B) - Found 14" dia. (was 6"), Hemlock Stump, 10' tall, bears (S 47° W 6.7'), healed scar and tag. (Map B-1226 A&B) - Found 16" dia. (was 8"), Hemlock Stump, 1' tall, bears (S 30° E 13.6'), axe work visible. () Indicates record information, Tillamook County Survey Records.
