ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, October 27, 1891.

Post; missing.

- 18" Hemlock bears N10°E 50 lks.; missing.
- 30" Cedar bears S70°E 68 lks.; missing.
- 20" Hemlock bears S01½°W 71 lks.; now 40" with 100 plus year
old axe work by ring count. Apparent face rotted out.
- 26" Hemlock bears N70°W 25 lks.; missing.

Found old grown over blazes to the East.

Var. 18½°E

Set a 1½"x40" galvanized iron pipe with 3 3/4" bronze cap marked
T3NR8WS18S17S19S202000LS1998, 34" in ground, in mound of stone,
and from which a:

- 28" Cedar bears N59°E 32.7 ft. to face; scribed T3NR8WS17BT.
- 47" Cedar bears S41°E 25.6 ft. to face; scribed T3NR8WS20BT.
- 24" Hemlock bears S61°W 36.8 ft. to face; scribed
T3NR8WS19BT.
- 19" Hemlock bears N73½°W 9.6 ft. to face; scribed
T3NR8WS18BT.

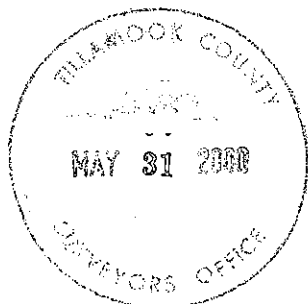
Metal location poster on BTs.
