


Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 2 1/2" G.L.O. Brass Cap leaning badly with concrete and rock collar disturbed, in a recently logged area, on a steep hillside. The monument was set in BLM Field Notes Volume: OR-R0567 Page 95 (1956). The monument is stamped as shown hereon. We used the only remaining accessories, as best physical evidence, to straighten the monument. We then tied the monument directly using GPS established control. The Oregon North Zone State Plane in NAD 83/91 grid coordinate for the monument is N = 631820.777, E = 7368628.229, US Survey Feet. (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (Hemlock 16" diam. bears S 81° E 12 lks. [7.92']). (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (Hemlock 9" diam. bears N 51°30' W 24 lks. [15.84']). (Book 1, Page 236) – Did not find the (26" Hemlock bears S 30° W 23 feet slope distance). (Book 1, Page 236) – Found 20" dia. rotted Hemlock Stub (was 18"), 6' tall, bears (S 45° E 34.5' slope distance) scribe partially visible. (BLM Field Notes) – Did not find the (Hemlock 10 ins. diam., bears S 19 1/4° E 58 lks. [38.28']). (BLM Field Notes) – Did not find the (Hemlock 10 ins. diam., bears N 70° W 71lks. [46.86']). (Book 7, Page 375) – Found Hemlock uproot, out of position, (was 15" Hemlock N 12° E 19.39 feet). (Book 7, Page 375) – Found 17" Hemlock Stub, 7' tall, bears (N 86° E 20.66 feet) scribing visible, yellow metal location tag, used nail and washer to position the corner. (Book 7, Page 375) – Found (72" light hat section post) lying down. () Indicates record information, Tillamook County Survey Records. [] Indicates converted value from links to feet.

New accessories set: Reset rock collar and 120 lbs. of concrete in an irregular mass. Reset found hat section post North 3.0' from monument.		
New Bearing Trees set: 30" dia. Cedar bears S 68° E 77.2', scribed "1/4 S36 BT", with a yellow metal location tag and an aluminum nail with washer marked "Till. Co. Surveyor" nailed to the face.		
Location & Comments: Corner is located approx. 50' westerly of a gravel logging road, on a steep slope, in a clear cut.
