


Brass Cap, up 0.5'. The monument is stamped as shown hereon. Found a white painted Cedar post Northwesterly 1.4' from monument. (GLO) – Did not find the (12" Alder bears N 43°30' E 63 lks. [41.58']). (GLO) – Found Hemlock stub, 7' tall, was (12" Hemlock bears S 64°30' E 6 lks. [3.96']), scribing visible. (GLO) – Found Hemlock stub, 2' tall, was (12" Hemlock bears S 24° W 21 lks. [13.86']) scribe marks visible. (GLO) – Did not find the (10" Hemlock bears N 30° W 85 lks. [56.10']). (Book 1, Page 319) – Did not find the (35" Hemlock bears N 27° W 44.2').
