Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 3" diameter Tillamook County brass cap in 10" monument box encased in concrete. Found a Hat Section post at record position (East 19.25' Rewitness Book 6, Page 488). Found a 1-1/4" iron rod in gravel lane at the P.I. of Tideland Road (Southerly 420.2' Rewitness Card #139). Did not search for the bent 3/4" iron rod located Northerly 1663.1' (Rewitness Card #139).		<input type="checkbox"/> Referenced Out	
Monument Set (Procedures and Description): Set a 2" diameter brass disk inside the found monument box with concrete at the road surface. The set 2" diameter brass disk is stamped as shown hereon. We referenced the found monument with two mag nails with center punch at 1.11' Northerly and 1.02' Easterly. Two (2) reference monuments being 5/8" X 30" rebar with a red plastic cap stamped "TILLAMOOK CO SURVEY" were set at the bearings and distances described below. An assumed compass backsight bearing of North was used to set the two (2) reference monuments. The reference monuments were set in existing fence lines on both the East and West sides of Tideland Road.	Sketch of Set Monument:		
New accessories set: Set a 5/8" X 30" rebar with a red plastic cap stamped "Tillamook Co. Survey" as a reference accessory to the corner monument that bears South 48° East 27.32'. Set a 5/8" X 30" rebar with a red plastic cap stamped "Tillamook Co. Survey" as a reference accessory to the corner monument that bears South 37° West 34.62'.			
New Bearing Trees set: No new bearing trees set. There are no available trees in the area.
