History, condition, and sources:

In 1857 the General Land Office had a post set for the quarter corner and 2 accessories. In 1887 (Hayes "F" pg. 88) Hayes reset corner off 2 found accessories. In 1947 (A-256) Sheppard set an iron pipe for quarter section corner but no new accessories. In 1950 (bk 1 pg.87) W.E. Anderson found the iron pipe set by Sheppard and added 2 new accessories. In 1965 (Rewitness bk. 5 pg. 96) the Tillamook County Surveyors office found the iron pipe set by Sheppard badly bent; pipe was then straightened and reset to position using bearing trees. The Tillamook County Surveyors office added 1 new accessory. In 1970 (Rewitness bk. 5 pg. 96) County Surveyor John Carlich replaced found 1" iron pipe with a 2" iron pipe; no new accessories. In 1972 (Rewitness card # 270) the Tillamook County Surveyors office set a 2" iron pipe with a brass cap in concrete inside a 12" tile stamped as shown hereon and added 1 new accessory.
