History, condition, and sources:

In 1867 Samuel Snowden was contracted by the General Land Office to set quarter section corner for the line between sections 13 and 14. He set a quarter section post and 2 bearing trees. In 1889 (Rewitness bk. 10 pg. 65) A. Phillnick Deputy County Surveyor, found the quarter section post and 1 accessory set by G.L.O. In 1950 (Rewitness bk. 1 pg. 93) County Surveyor W.E. Anderson set 1 1/4" iron pipe for the quarter section corner and added 3 new accessories. In 1974 (Rewitness card #297) the Tillamook County Surveyors office found the 1 1/2" Iron pipe set for the corner and replaced it with a 2" iron pipe with 3" Tillamook County brass cap in 10" tile and concrete stamped as shown hereon. The County Surveyors office found 2 existing accessories and added 3 new accessories. In (Rewitness card #297) 1998 County Surveyor Danny Mcnutt added an 84" light hat section post with yellow metal location tag. In 2022 the Tillamook County Surveyors office visited the corner and found the monument to be in good condition (not legible) but no trace of any of the previous accessories were found.
