Notice is hereby given that the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on November 8, 2023, beginning at 10:00am, at the Board of County Commissioners Meeting Room 106 in Tillamook, Oregon, 201 Laurel Avenue, to consider the following:

Road Rename Request #851-23-000485-PLNG: An application has been filed with the Tillamook County Department of Community Development at the request of the Tillamook County Public Works Department to rename a portion of Cape Meares Loop Road to Lighthouse Road. The area of roadway is located within Section 18, Township 1 South, Range 10 West of the Willamette Meridian, Tillamook County, Oregon. This road rename request is in conjunction with the completion of the Cape Meares Loop Road realignment project to rename that portion of the historic road alignment that connects to the Cape Meares Lighthouse State Park now separate from Cape Meares Loop Road. Applicant is the Tillamook County Public Works Department.





Road Renaming Letter of Justification

October 12th, 2023

RE: Renaming a prior alignment to avoid road name redundancy Cape Meares Loop; Tillamook County Road #780 Township 01 South, Range 10 West, Section 18

Cape Meares Loop is a long established county road. Unfortunately, the original alignment crossed a historic slide zone which resulted in multiple failures of the roadbase. The new alignment, which was developed to avoid this geologic hazard, leaves behind a remnant portion of the original road. The northern portion of the prior alignment is intended to remain as a closed road. However, the southern portion connects to the Cape Meares Lighthouse State Park and will remain open to the traveling public.

This request is being filed in order to avoid the potential confusion which would result from having multiple roads in close proximity which bear the same name. TCPW is requesting that the southern portion of the prior alignment be renamed Lighthouse Road.
