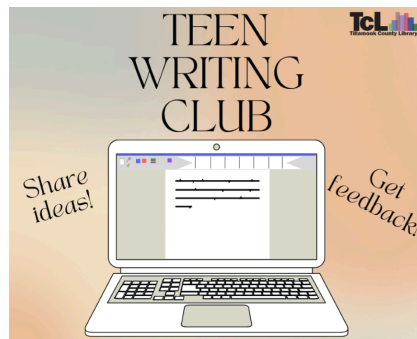


Summer Reading Movie: Wall-E

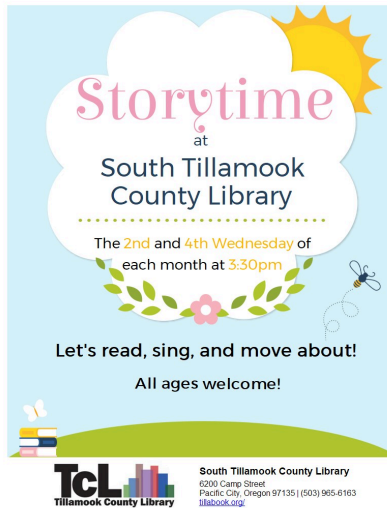
Wall-E is rated G.

Summer Reading: Kazuyo Ito at Bay City

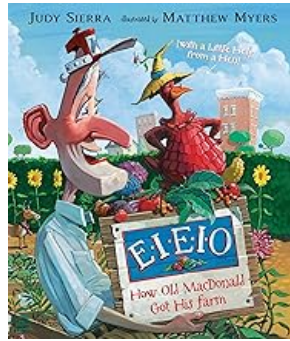

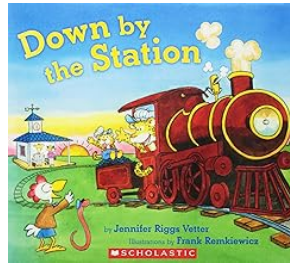
Children's Books You Can Sing

Jennifer Riggs Vetter

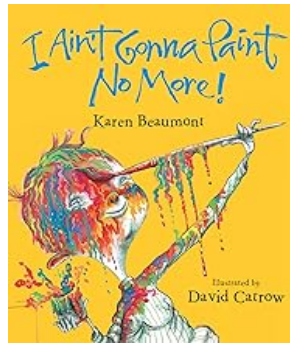
This illustrated version of the traditional song expands and describes more vehicles, different locations, and their unique sounds, from puffer-billies to racecars and rockets.

Sharon Hampson, Lois Lilienstein, Bram Morrison, and Randi Hampson

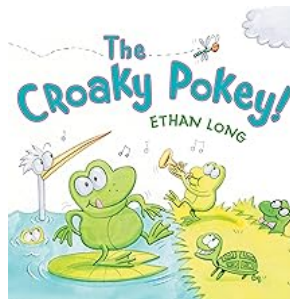
