The Board of Commissioners for Tillamook County ORDAINS as follows:

Section 1. Justice of the Peace District Boundaries

The Justice of the Peace District for Tillamook County be and is hereby established to be coterminous with the exterior boundaries of Tillamook County as more particularly described in ORS Chapter 201 and the Oregon Constitution.

Section 2. Qualifications of Justice

In addition to the qualifications set forth in ORS Chapter 51, a person shall not be eligible to the office of Justice of the Peace unless the person is a member of the Oregon State Bar or the bar association of any other state.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Provisions

All other ordinances or orders or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or unlawful, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board hereby declares that it would have passed each phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of such provisions be declared unconstitutional or unlawful.


